GWP plans to expand the dirty fossil fuel Grayson power plant, increasing the plant's toxic emissions by nearly 700%.
That's like adding 90,000 gas-burning cars to Glendale roads.

HEALTH RISKS INCLUDE

Greater risk of asthma, heart disease, kidney disease, and cancer.
Lowered IQ, neurological degeneration, and impaired coordination in children.
Increased likelihood of dementia in elderly residents.

Studies show that natural gas plants have significant negative impacts on the health of local residents.

When California passes laws that phase out dirty fossil fuel power Grayson will be forced to close.
Glendale residents would then be solely responsible for the remainder of the project's \$500 million bond debt.

If the City of Los Angeles is studying clean alternatives for their energy needs, why can't Glendale?
